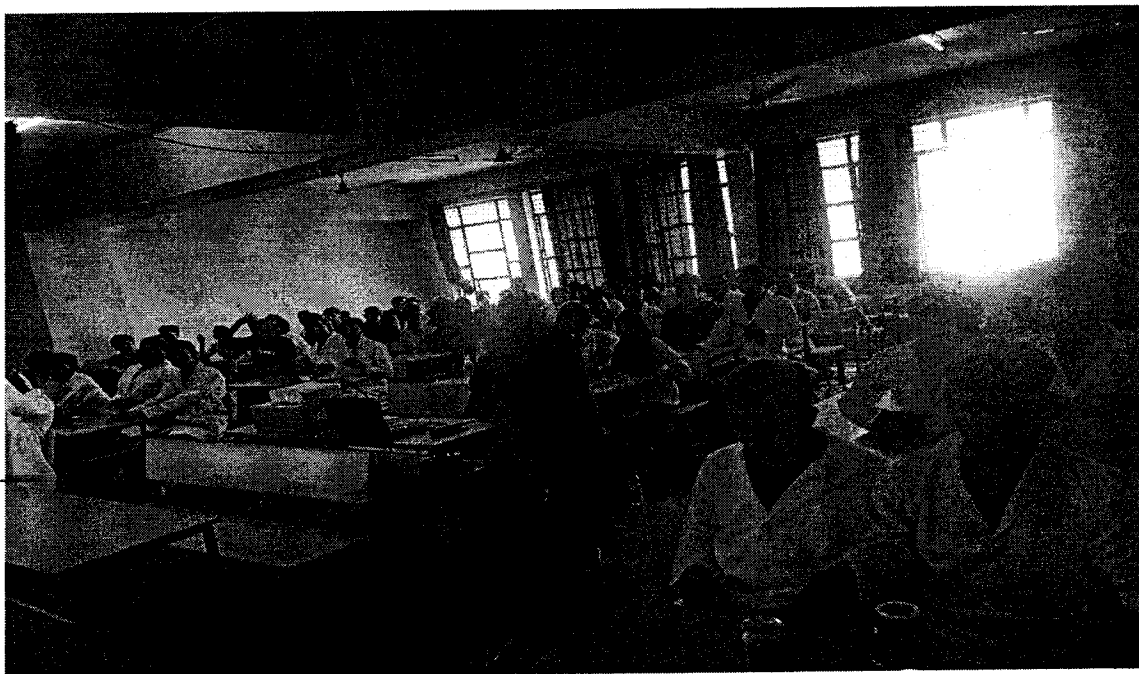
Conclusion:

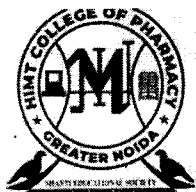
The event ended on a positive note, with the faculty encouraging the students to continue exploring these topics in their legal studies and beyond.

Introduction:

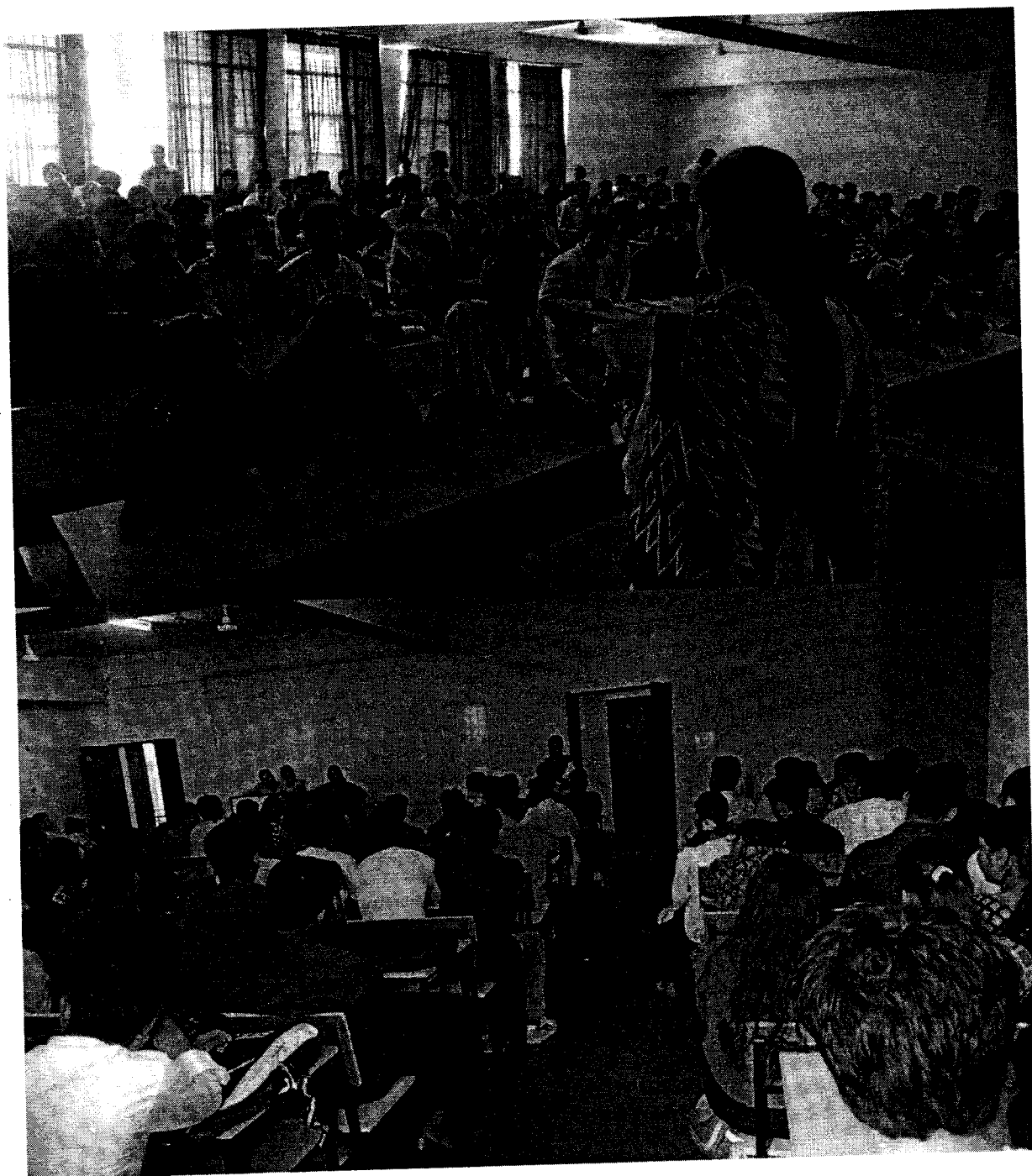
On the first day of the induction program at HIMT College of Pharmacy, activities were conducted Pharmaceutical Quiz competition.

in the Pharmacist Oath activity, and Ms. Pinky Baghel administered the oath to all the students while explaining their duties and responsibilities in the profession.

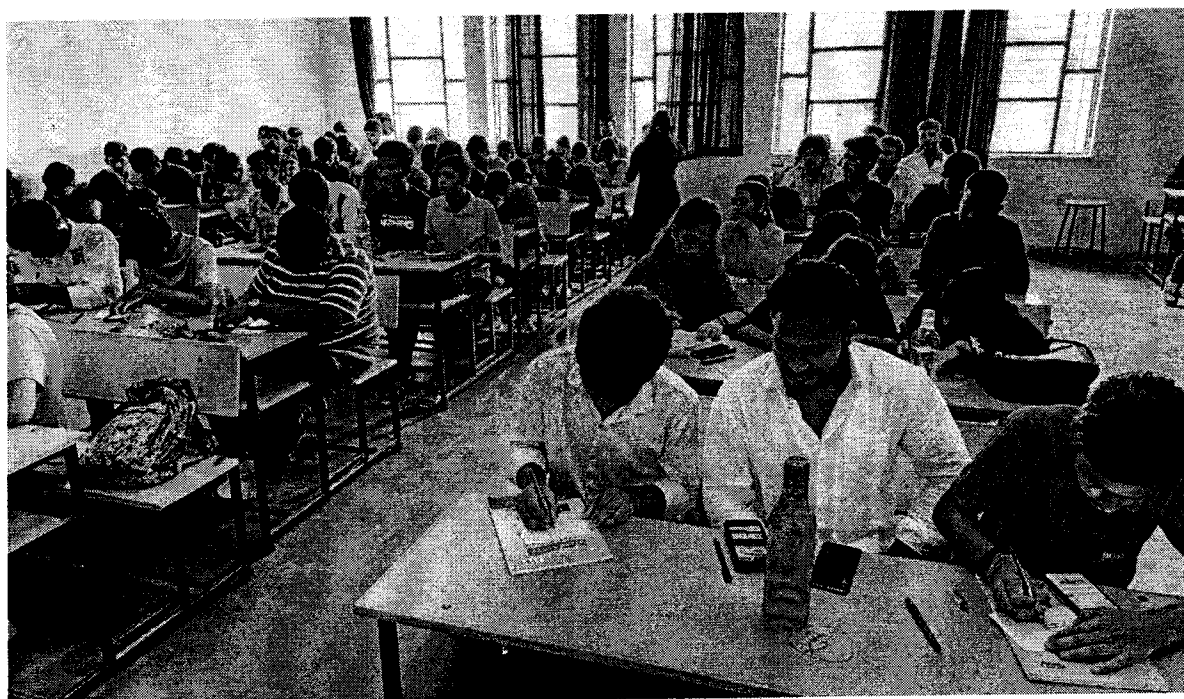

Objectives of the Lecture:

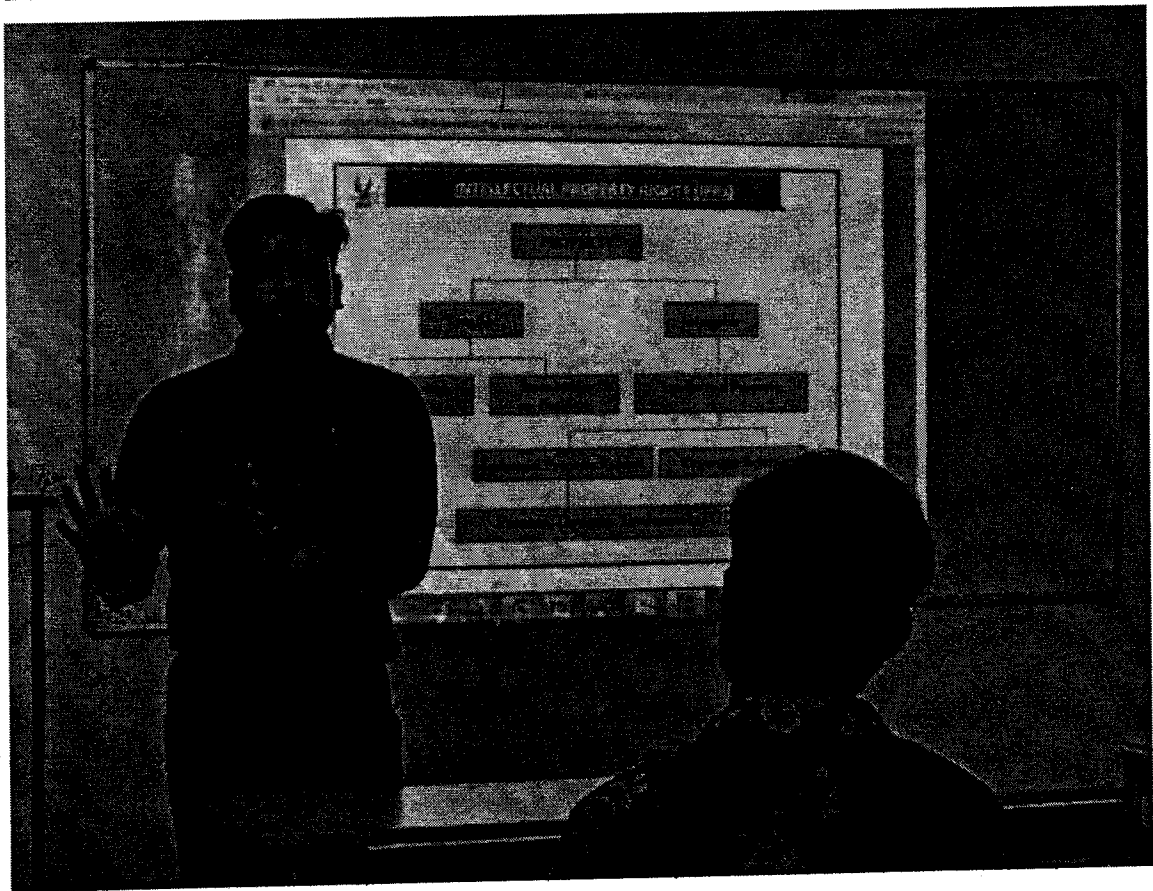
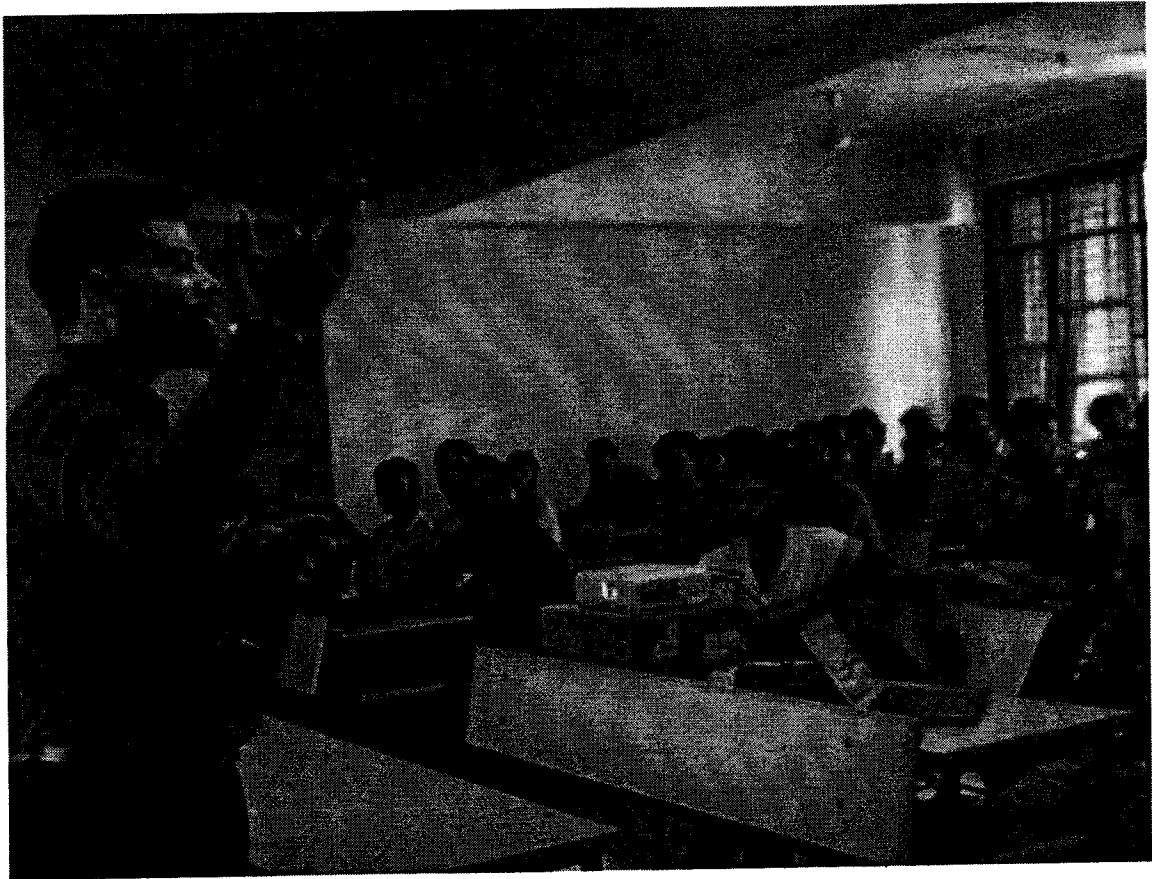

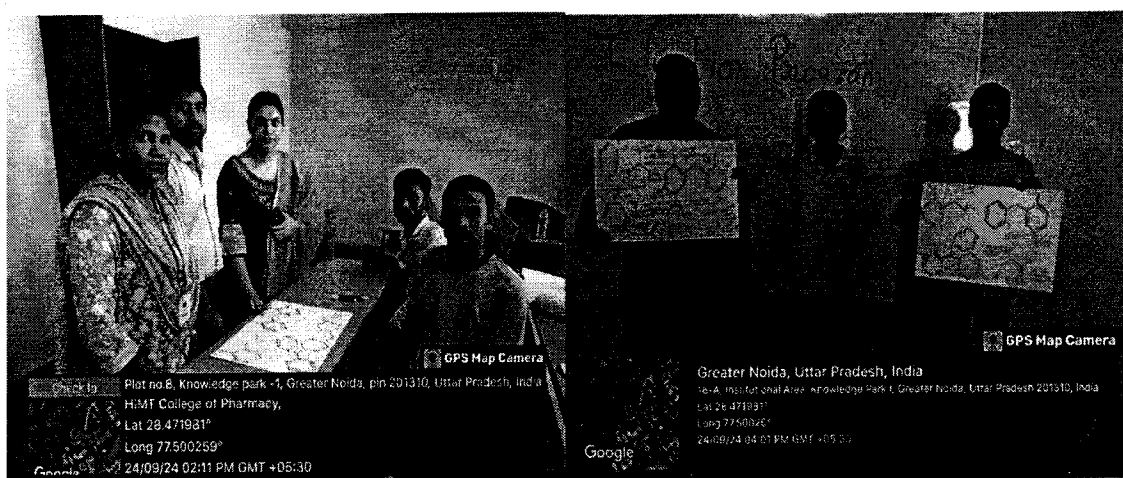
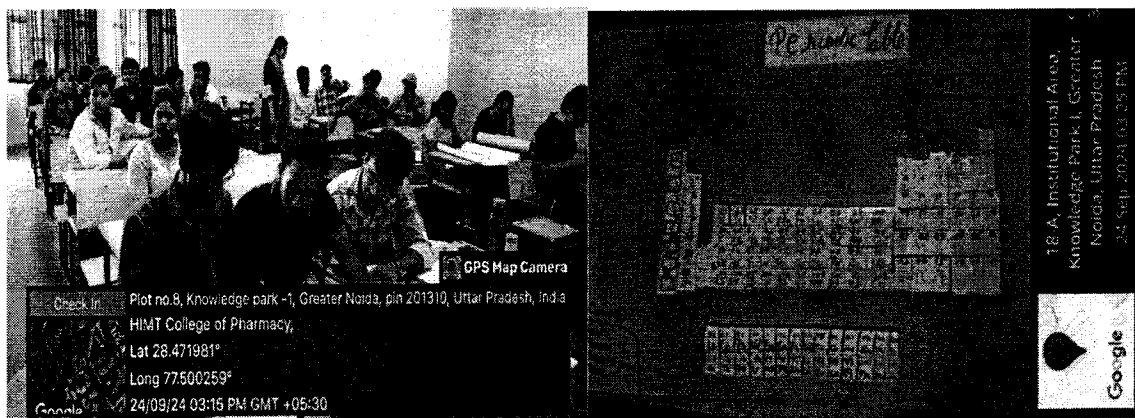
Introduction:

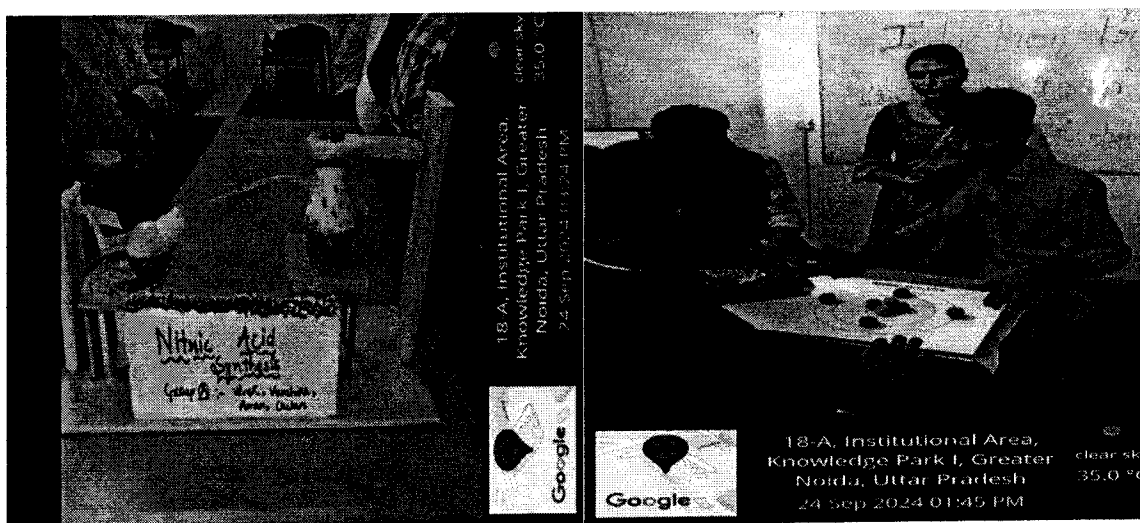
Activity 1: Creative arts

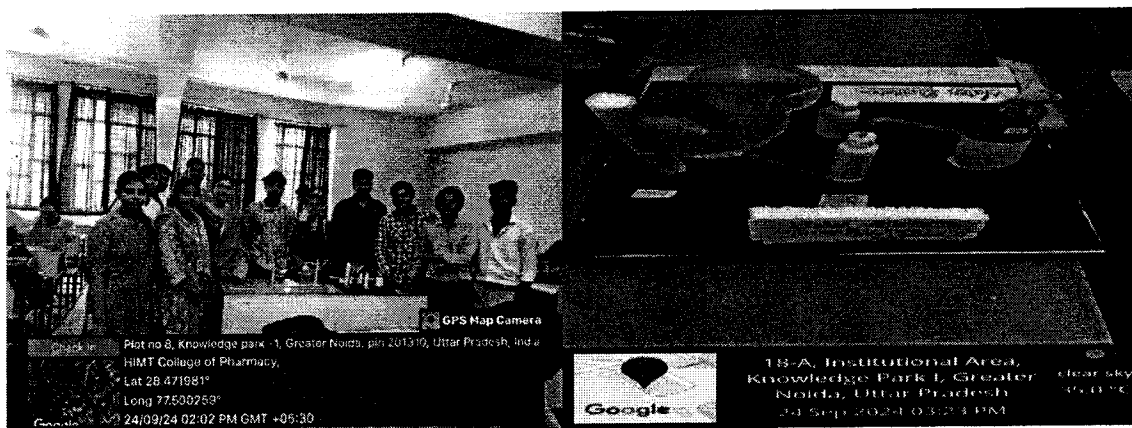

Activity 2: Chemistry Model

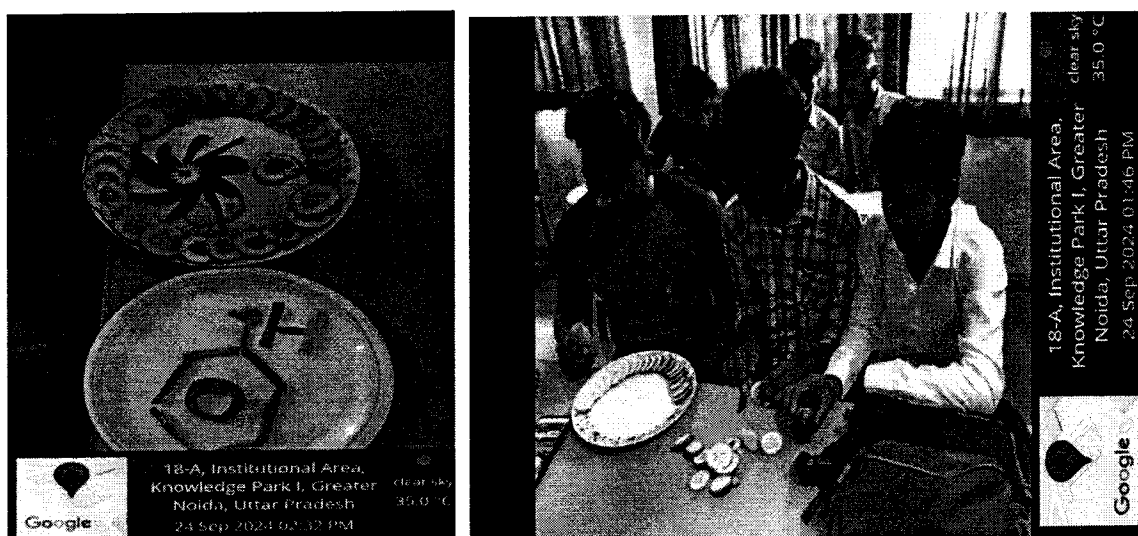

- **Body Mass Index Calculation**

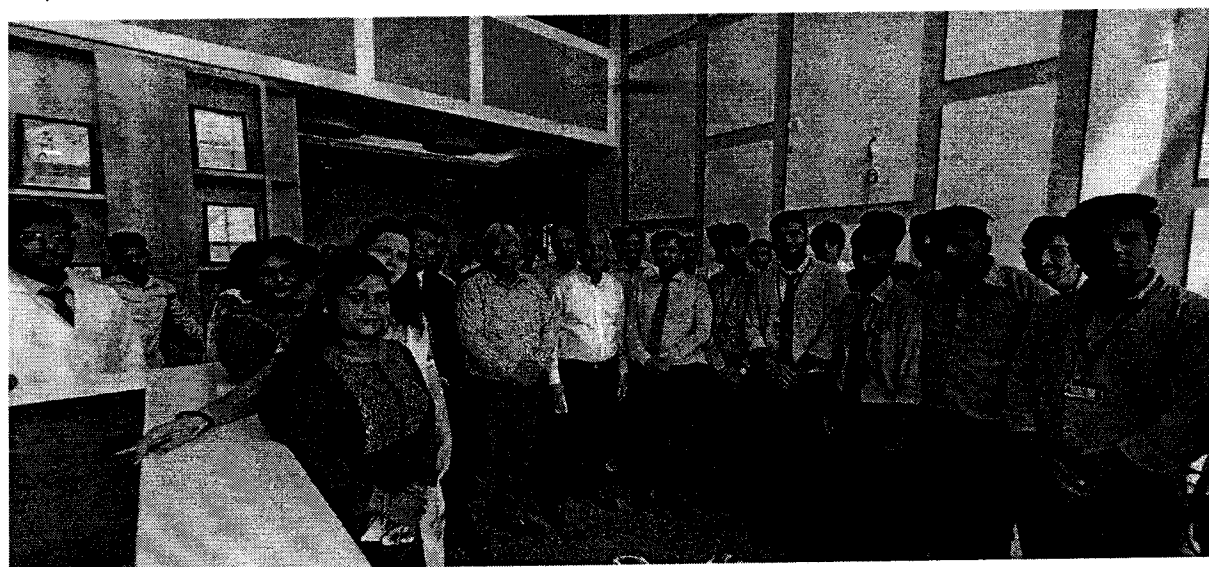
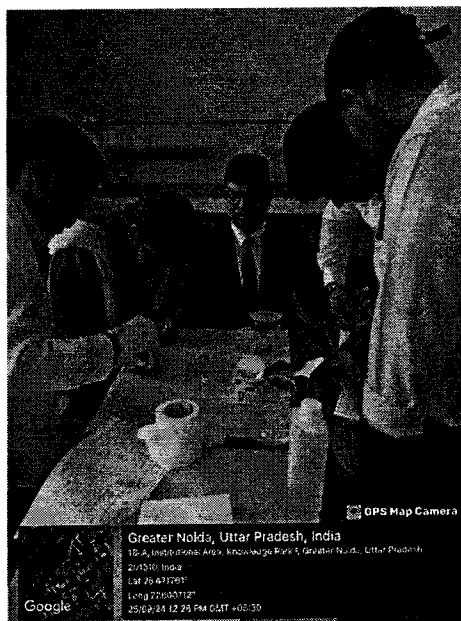
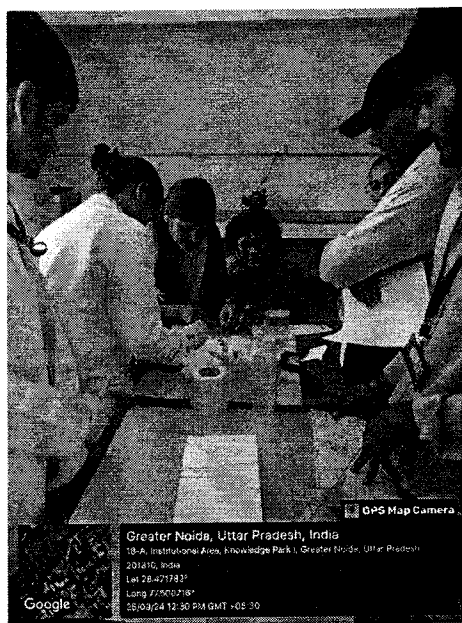
